Loving Greetings from Sr. Nicol DSS of Nirmala Province, Mysore. I would like to briefly inform about the corona situation in our region.


- The second wave of Covid-19 is very severe comparing to the first wave because the death rate has increased day by day in Bangalore and Mysore. One side People are panic, no beds are available to treat the covid patient especially whose saturation oxygen level is below 90. On the other side most of them are suffering at home itself being afraid of the poor medical aid. Now a days positive case are increasing in the village side where there is no hospitals and availability of medicine.
- Regarding the covid vaccination most of them are not received the vaccination because of the shortage and yet to receive it. Recently two of our institution in which our staff and inmates were provided vaccination from the government officers. For the age between 18 above still vaccination is not available.
- In our dispensaries of Cowdally, Santhipura, Nagavally, Kongarapatty, Vallavilai, Eryamanthurai of both the states of Karnataka and Tamilnadu our sisters were selflessly involved themselves to treat the patients and in two communities of Kongarapatty and Vallavilai our sisters also affected with the symptoms of corona. Now all are keeping well recovered from their illness.
- During the first wave of covid we were able to go out and involve ourselves in service to those who were suffering mainly in providing food items, medical aid and sanitizers, masks etc. It did not affect our normal life taking lot of precautions we have helped many who were in need at that time but for the second wave of covid the rules of the government is strict and everywhere lockdown and day and night curfew was imposed so we couldn't go out to help those suffering ones. Many priests and nuns have lost their lives during this second wave of covid as we too have lost one of our enthusiastic, zealous and committed pioneer of our Province.
- We have provided food kits, sanitizer, masks, and medical aid for the first wave of Covid and for the second wave we are planning to provide them with food kits, medical aid, if possible with the counseling as many are lost their jobs and finding difficulty to have their daily needs and wants.

- We have collaborated with the diocese of Mysore and distributed medicine kits for the covid patients in villages through our dispensaries.
- I assure that I will use this help only for the poor children and families with children only. Here with I attach the photos help which we have extended for the poor people.
